We have further extended our services to electrification for domestic, commercial and rail clients and have established a team dedicated for handling maintenance and new installations.





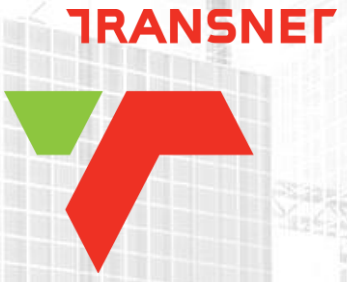

Gebane Engineering Services has invested in a state-of-the-art mobile oil purification and vacuum systems needed to purify transformer oil.



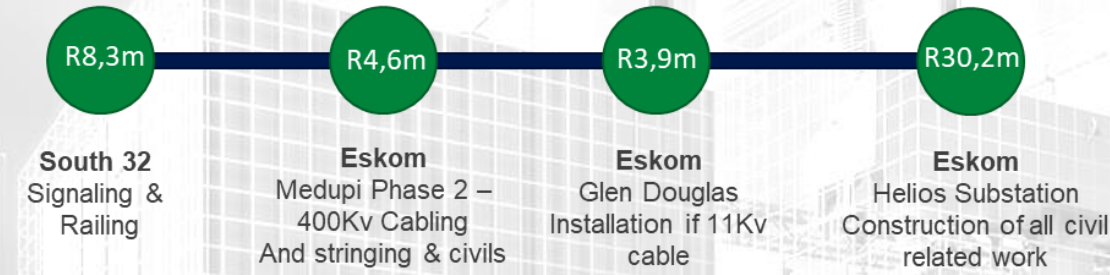

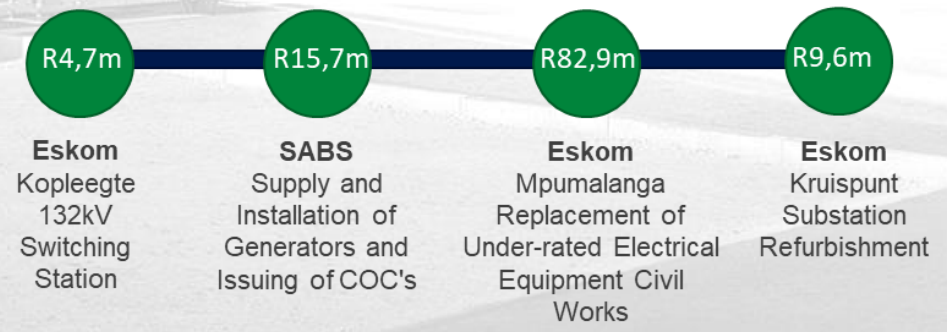

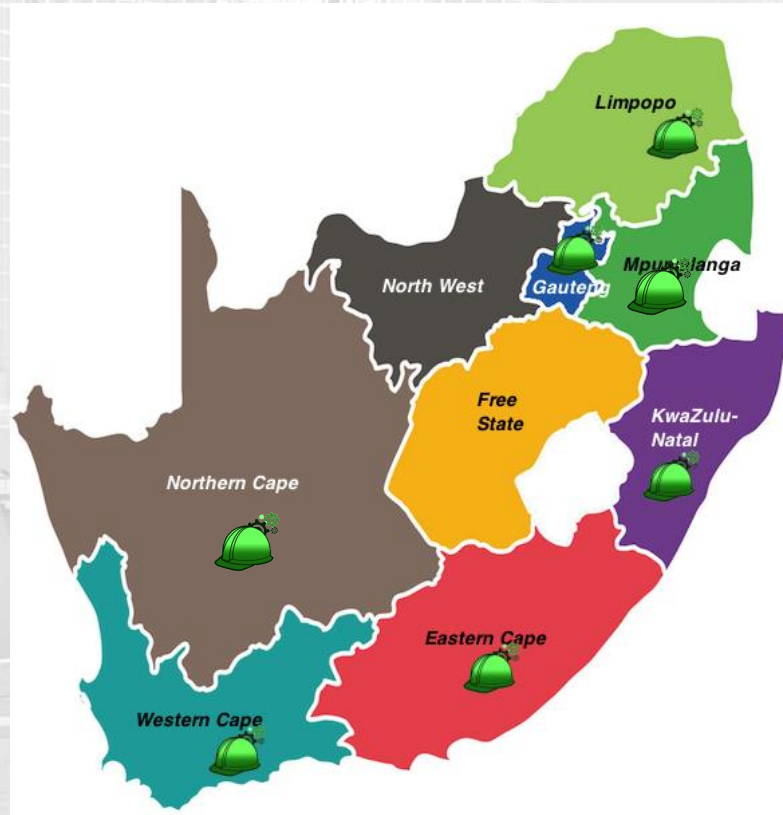
